Parking for 202 Broadway, Westville

There is parking anywhere on Broadway except two spaces directly in front of Bob's Mini Market across the street from our house. Please avoid parking so as to block any of our neighbors' driveways. There is also public, free parking in three Borough owned lots nearby:

- 1. On the same side of Broadway as our house there is public parking in a lot that is behind the Speranza Restaurant. This parking can be accessed using Pine Street which forms the corner nearest our house. From Broadway go west on Pine Street and look on the right for the parking lot entrance which begins with a single row of parking spots. As you drive in there is likely more room than first meets the eye, keep going until you find a spot.
- 2. Also, there is parking behind the Westville Square Building which is directly across the street from our house that can be reached using the alley, aka Pine Street, that runs between the Westville Square building and Lorenzo's Cabana (Restaurant). As you clear the end of the building on the right, the parking is at the rear and to the right. Avoid the parking on the left of the alley which is parking for Schileen's Tavern.

3. There is parking in front of Borough Hall accessed from Broadway. Mind the signs, many spots are reserved for the Police.

NOTE: Do not park in the small parking area on Pine Street and associated with the Bail Bond Agency at 200 Broadway which is the other side of the twin where César and I live. There is a very good chance you will be towed.

4. By prior arrangement you may use our driveway to park. Call so we can discuss this possibility.
